



# Lodge Rules 2021

1. On arrival please check in with the Manager, who will direct you to your room and kitchen facilities and provide linen.
2. All food must be put away in food cupboards, refrigerators, and freezers. Cardboard boxes/ esky's, bottles etc, are not to be left in the pantry area or on the balcony.
3. Members are entitled to bring three guests only, unless a request for additional guests is requested in writing(email) to the committee . Members are fully responsible for their guests' behaviour in the lodge at all times, ensuring they conform to all rules of the club. Guests must be accompanied upon arrival at and upon departure from the lodge and under no circumstances will guests be permitted to stay at the lodge on their own. The practice of requesting members staying in the lodge to sponsor guests unknown to them is not condoned. Should a member agree to do this they are then responsible for that person/s until they depart.
4. Smoking is strictly forbidden in the ENTIRE LODGE, at ALL times and within a designated area of the lodge building.
5. The consumption of food or alcohol in the bedrooms is strictly forbidden. This means breakfast or other meals are not to be taken to a room, unless there is an emergency.
6. Children under the age of five (5) years are not allowed to stay in the lodge, except during approved children's week(s). Children under the age of 15 are not permitted in the Lodge without a parent or adult even if they are members in their own right.
7. Cleaning of food lockers, refrigerators, trays, and vacuuming of rooms plus cleaning of the en-suite area must be done before vacating the lodge. Upon arrival members are requested to advise the manager immediately if they find the rooms unsatisfactory. There is a fine of \$55 to the member should the room be left in an unsatisfactory way. Should anything be spilled on the blankets or underlays please advise the Manager immediately and he will assist with replacements and advice on washing.
8. Members must clean cooking areas after use (including the griller) and in particular work bench areas. If drinks, coffee, nibbles are served in the lounge, please wipe tables after use and in particular take all dishes to the kitchen, wash and put away.
9. A commercial dishwasher is available in the kitchen for members' use. Due to it's very quick cycle (2 minutes), it is imperative that all dishes be fully rinsed before loading to ensure that dishes are washed properly (instructions for the use of this machine will be posted in the kitchen). Your clean dishes must then be put away by the member or guest.

10. The Manager will wash breakfast dishes if they are rinsed, and stacked neatly before 9.00 am each morning.
11. Microwave ovens are not to be used for defrosting during meal times.
12. The lounge area is not to be used as a dining area. Members are requested to use the dining area for all meals.
13. Members and their guests are requested to hang their ski clothes in the drying room and not leave them on the floor, benches, or heater. Boots and skis must be put on pegs and ski racks in the drying room area.
14. Members and their guests are requested to dress suitably in the common areas (ie lounge, kitchen, and foyer) which means no swimwear singlets or pyjamas. Shoes or casual footwear must be worn in lounge, dining and kitchen areas; bare feet are not acceptable.
15. Linen must be used on all beds. Bed Linen is included in the tariff.
16. Vacating time from the rooms is 5 pm.
17. Please turn off lights, and turn heaters to low (3) in bedrooms when unoccupied.
18. Laundry: Washing machines and dryers Operating Hours 8 am until 10 pm.
